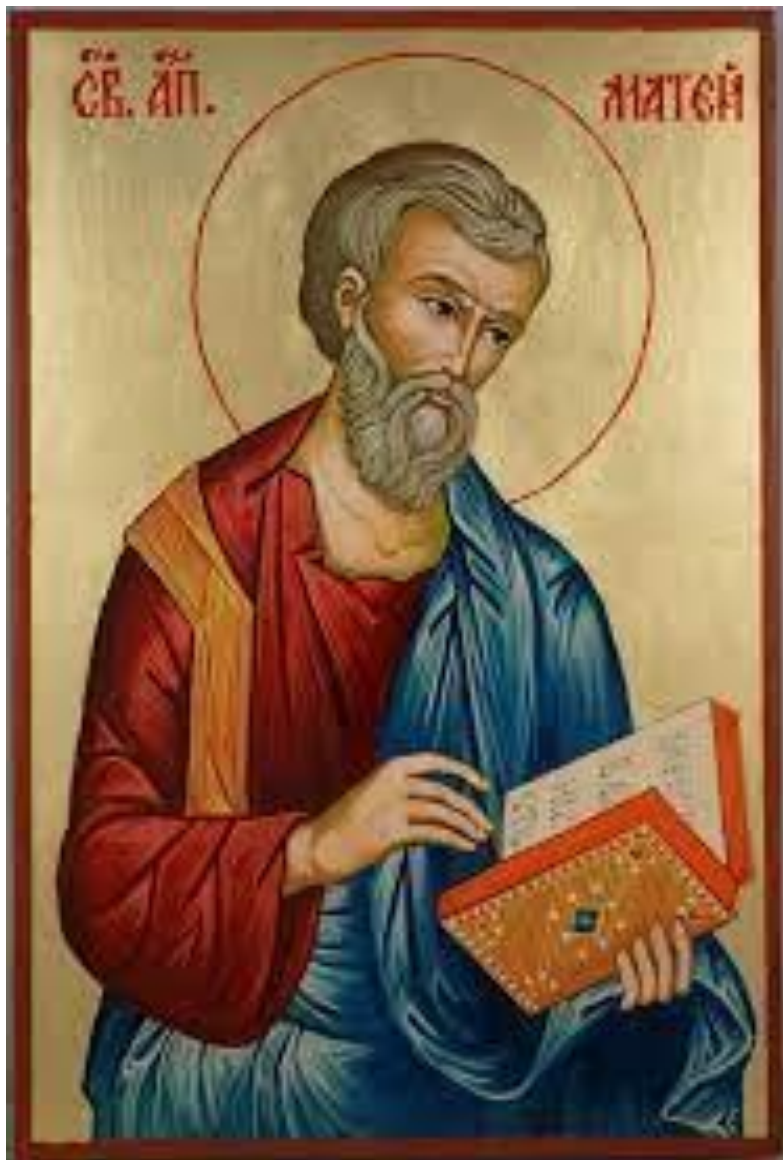

The Gospel: Mark 9: 30-37
